

2017-2018 Hokey Pokey Scholarship Application
Deadline: September 1st

Purpose of Scholarship: To provide scholarships to assist second year music students with educational expenses at the College of Southern Idaho (Twin Falls) while honoring Roland L. LaPrise who co-wrote the popular song, the “Hokey Pokey”. The scholarship amount for each recipient shall be a minimum of \$500 per year.

Eligibility:

- a) Must be a full-time, second year student enrolled in the music program
- b) Recipients of the scholarship need not demonstrate financial need nor does the receipt of another award (unless it pays academic fees) preclude receipt of this scholarship
- c) As part of the application process, applicants shall submit a brief essay (up to one page) describing the difference that music has made in their lives, why they chose it as a course of study and what music means to them
- d) Preference may be given to applicants who reside in Idaho
- e) At least one alternate will be named in case a first candidate becomes ineligible and
- f) No family member of direct descent of Roland LaPrise shall be eligible for consideration
- g) Essay must be typed and attached to this form
- h) Turn in applications to CSI Scholarship Coordinator
